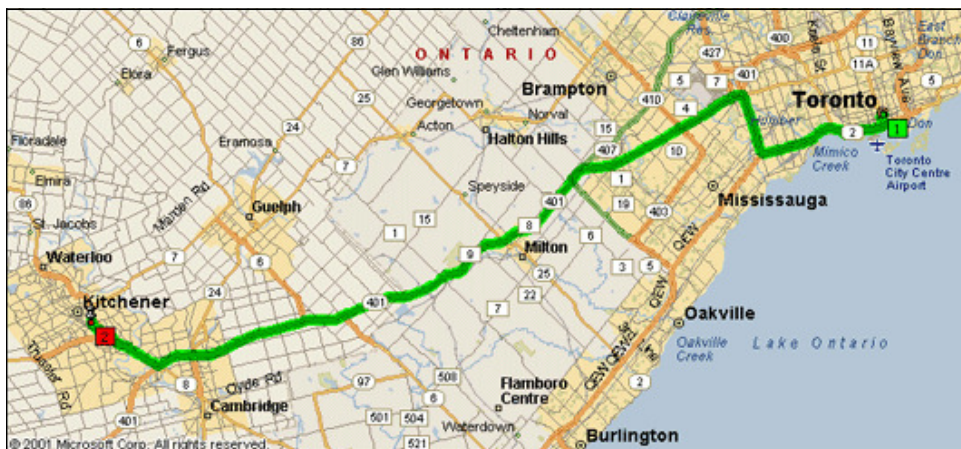

Liability Agreement

I (we) acknowledge that The German Shepherd Dog Club of Canada Inc and Performance Dogs Canada has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the organizing committee shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this agility trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and win ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents, sponsors of the events, or trial secretary and the owner or lessee of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the agility trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto. I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this agility trial, howsoever such injuries death or damage to property may be caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

General Information	<p>The Trial Secretary and Superintendent is in full charge of the Trials. The show precincts shall consist of 30 feet around the ring area. Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not permitted to use whistles, clickers, flexis or other instruments or devices in the ring or within 10 feet of the course. Bitches in Season are also NOT permitted within 30 feet of ring area. Dogs <u>must</u> be ON LEASH at all times when outside the rings.</p>
Event Information	<p>Ring Surface is grass. The ring will be enclosed with fencing on four sides and 2 openings. There is no cover/shade available. Handlers in all classes will be able to walk their course, without their dog prior to the start of the class. Handlers must be ready at the start line when called or risk forfeiting their run. If a dog is not at ringside after it has been called 3 times, it will be marked absent.</p>
Obstacles	<p>Obstacle familiarization will be available for Novice classes immediately prior to the first Novice Standard class of EACH day. Only those dogs who are NOT entered on Saturday may participate in the Sunday familiarization. Obstacles shall meet the specifications in the CKC Agility Rules and Regulations effective January 1, 2007.</p>
Eligibility	<p>To be eligible to compete in these trials, a dog must be 18 mos. of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN or CKC Miscellaneous Certificate or Performance Event Number (PEN) Spayed bitches, debarked dogs, and neutered males are eligible to participate.</p>
Bitches in Season	<p>Bitches in season may not compete. When a bitch comes into season after the entry has closed a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial must reach the secretary on or before the start of the trial. A full refund of entry fees and listing fees will be given.</p>
Trophies	<p>Rosettes/ribbons will be given for 1st to 4th qualifying scores in all Jump Heights. New Title Rosettes will be offered.</p>
Food Concession	<p>Food will be available for purchase at the show site. Lunch provided for volunteers.</p>

Alterations, substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited, except as noted in this premium list. **The ONLY exception is bitches in season. Unfortunately we can not refund any entries for injured dogs that we receive after the closing**

Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.

Job Descriptions

Gate Steward: Makes sure exhibitors are at the gate, in the correct order and ready to run

Ring Steward: Sets bars to correct positions prior to each jump height in a class. Re-sets dropped bars, straightens chute

Leash Runner: Takes exhibitor's leash from start line and places it at finish

Sheet Runner: Takes scribe sheet from Combiner and gives it to the score table

Scribe: Marks faults on scribe sheet as they are called by the judge

Timer: Times the dogs' runs using a stopwatch

Combiner (will be used if trials are very large): Hands scribe correct scribe sheet, writes time on scribe sheet, clears stopwatch for timer, hands sheet to sheet runner.

Course Builder: Assists the Chief Course Builder with putting obstacles in the correct position as indicated by the judge

Judges' Profiles

Joan Greenwald

Joan has been playing agility for over 10 years with Newfoundlands and Border Collies, and before that obedience for longer than she wants to admit. She has been an AKC agility judge since 2000, and is also a AKC Rally Obedience judge. In her "real" life she is a biologist who left the field to open a boarding kennel and stable where she boards and grooms dogs, and runs obedience and agility classes five nights a week. At the stable she does trail rides and riding lessons.

Mike Bitz, an agility competitor for over five years, has been judging Masters level AAC agility since January 2004 and CKC since January 2006. He and his wife Sue breed Bergers des Pyrénées under the VAL-DAZUN prefix. Mike trials three of his Pyrenean Shepherds and also competes in the Canadian Disc Dog Association. Mike loves the sport of agility. It gives him another activity to play, train and bond with his dogs, as well as a chance to meet new people who share a common interest in the sport of agility and most importantly a fondness for our four legged family members. "See you out on the course - Run clean & have FUN!!"

Are you in the correct agility class?

Selected Class: Any dog eligible to enter an agility trial may enter the Selected Class but can not be entered in the Selected Class and Regular Class at the same set of trials. Dogs entering the Selected Class must progress through the various levels beginning with the Novice level. When entering this class your dog will jump one jump height lower than its Regular jump height and this class will get 10% more time than the Regular Standard course time. For full rules on the Selected Class please refer to the Official CKC Agility rule book.

Please note: Novice JWW will have one set of 6 weave poles used once.

Novice A is for persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title in any country or with any organization.

Novice B is for agility instructors and judges, and for dogs that have acquired the Novice title, but have not earned a qualifying score in Agility Intermediate; and for persons who have previously exhibited a dog to an agility title in any agility organization.

Excellent A is for dogs that have acquired the Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title in either Standard or JWW.

Excellent B is for dogs that have acquired the Excellent title or the Master Excellent Title. A dog may move up into Excellent B in only the Standard or JWW class that they have earned an Excellent Title in.
